American Union School Has Levels of Uranium Above Drinking Water Standards

Water produced by the sole well, Well 01 of our water system failed a drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what you should do, what happened and what we are doing to correct this situation. We routinely monitor for the presence of drinking water contaminants. Water sample results collected on 01/08/2016 showed uranium levels of 38.86 pCi/L. This is above the standard or maximum contaminant level (MCL) of 20 pCi/L. Compliance is based on average of four quarters of data.

What should I do?

- You <u>do not</u> need to use an alternative (e.g. bottled) water supply. However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.
- This is not an emergency. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately.
 However, some people who drink water containing uranium in excess of the MCL over many years may have kidney problems or an increased risk of getting cancer.
- If you have other health issues concerning the consumption of this water, you may wish to consult your doctor.

What happened? What was done?

Provide bottled water for concerned individuals.

We anticipate resolving the problem within 03/01/2019.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.

Secondary Notification Requirements

Upon receipt of notification from a person operating a public water system, the following notification must be given within 10 days [Health and Safety Code Section 116450(g)]:

- SCHOOLS: Must notify school employees, students, and parents (if the students are minors).
- RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PROPERTY OWNERS OR MANAGERS (including nursing homes and care facilities): Must notify tenants.
- BUSINESS PROPERTY OWNERS, MANAGERS, OR OPERATORS: Must notify employees of businesses located on the property.
